I learned about God's grace and that I wasn't condemned by my past mistakes. I will never forget the freedom that I found after releasing unforgiveness in my life. I now know that God loves me and will always be there for me. Life is a gift; I look forward to being the mother to my sons that He intended me to be!

From a young age, I dealt with substance abuse, starting with alcohol at twelve and progressing into harder drugs. Throughout my adulthood, I continued to use drugs even after the birth of my children, I was stuck in bondage. After my marriage fell apart, I fell deeper into addiction, causing me to break my families trust through lying and stealing. My family eventually distanced themselves. If not for Central Oklahoma Adult & Teen Challenge, I would still be out there using drugs, in prison, or dead. Being offered this program was a blessing and gave me the tools I need to cope with depression and addiction. They showed me how to walk with Christ by discipling and mentoring me over the course of a year. I have developed a much more thorough understanding of the Bible. I've had full restoration with my family and they have shown me that I am starting to rebuild my trust with them. God has shown me my true purpose, and I am now looking forward to the future. From cocaine, to pain meds, to methamphetamine; the downward cycle of drug use slowly took control of my life. Drugs caused me to lose my marriage, children, job, house, and car. I was ashamed of who I had become and filled with guilt and condemnation over the hurt and disappointment that I had caused to the loved ones in my life. This only deepened my desire to use drugs. After being arrested, I came to terms with who I had become, and I was determined to change. At first, coming to Sonrise Ranch seemed like a low point, but this place has been beyond beneficial, allowing me to come to a place where I have been discipled and put into right standing with the Lord. Adult & Teen Challenge of Oklahoma gave me hope when I had none. They taught me that if you are in Christ, everything will work out for the good, even in the midst of struggles and hardships. Well, I am now a new creation in Christ. I learned how to have a true intimate relationship with Jesus. After graduating, I plan to stay plugged into this ministry and help others in

Slowly I became a rebellious teenager, and my life spiraled out of control. I was suspended and expelled from school multiple times. After spending some time at Brush Creek Ranch, I submitted my life to God and allowed Him to have His way and transform me. Not only have I progressed mentally and spiritually, but I am also physically healthy and much more active. God has humbled me through Adult & Teen Challenge and has shown me a better life. I now strive for success, after rediscovering true joy in life. I hope to become a pastor someday and help others who have struggled like me!








Merry Christmas to All!
