Life before Adult & Teen Challenge was filled with constant anger and malice. The things I did to people, the life I was living caused me to become numb to feelings. I became addicted to the lifestyle of gang activity and selling drugs. This led to me to using the drugs that I was selling. God was not really a part of my life. I was consumed by the gang lifestyle, which taught me to hate anyone who wasn't us. All of this drove my loved ones away. Although they loved me, I was not allowed to be around my family. I remember my mom being sad, but she never stopped praying for me. My Dad gave up and didn't want anything to do with me. The mother of my child kept my daughter away from me, but this life had a hold of me. The people that were around, I don't know if they were my friends, but they seemed to be around when they wanted something from me.


I remember when my addiction was at my worst. I was arrested, and when I was released, the people that I was living with moved and would not tell me where. I was forced to live on the street, staying at various acquaintances' houses. To be able to survive and get high, I would rob, steal, and sell drugs. My mom and sister wouldn't let me back in the house, so I was living like that for some time. My self-worth was at an all-time low.

When I was in jail, I met an older man who had been living the gang life most of his life. He was into the Bible and didn't want anything to do with gangs anymore. He would get onto me about doing bad things, and he explained to me that there was more to life than what we were doing with this gang. When I came eye to eye with him, I felt a change.

Entering Sonrise Adult & Teen Challenge, I was able to walk this new perspective out and be transformed. I decided to give my life to God and began to see myself change. Being in jail, I was really shut off from the world and anti-social, but here I learned to open up. Once where I hated people, I have learned to love and appreciate others. I have developed Godly friendships with other students that are seeking the same life transformation as me, I remember when the program took us to an Elevation Worship Concert, just seeing all the community genuinely loving and worshiping God was so powerful. That was the best feeling that I have ever had and gave me a new perspective.

Adult & Teen Challenge gave me a reason to start loving, allowing me to open my heart. I now see that God loves me and has always been there for me. While in this program, God has restored my relationship with my family and my daughter. I have become a dependable and committed person. I plan to continue serving the Lord through Adult & Teen Challenge by interning with Sonrise. One day, I hope to work with troubled adolescent teenage boys at Brush Creek Ranch. I feel like my story can help kids and keep them from straying onto the wrong path. I want to be there for somebody like God was there for me.

Adult & Teen Challenge




We are so blessed and grateful to have them on staff in Oklahoma, and we look forward to seeing the continuous progress being made in Stillwater!


